WHAT WAS SEIZED? TIMBER HAY BOTANICAL FOREST PRODUCTS PROPERTY OR CHATTELS

- REASON FOR THE SEIZURE (check one or more)
- Crown timber: the official believes was removed without authority (contravention of Section 96 of the *Forest Practices Code (FPC) Act*).
 - Timber or forest products, chattels for which there is an outstanding debt with the Government. (An outstanding debt with the Crown consists of a lien under Section 130(1) of the *Forest Act (FA)*. Excludes hay, livestock and botanical forest products [refer to definitions of "liens", "lien", "chattel"].) This includes logging timber products that the official has reasonable grounds to believe was:
 - not properly marked (Section 124 of the *FA*), applies to Crown or private land
 - not properly scaled (Section 125 of the *FA*);
 - being transported outside the province, unmanufactured, without proper exemption (Section 127 and 128 of the *FA*).
 - Botanical forest products which the official believes were being commercially traded without the person having a valid Dealer's Licence (Section 104, *FPC Act*).
 - Hay which was being cut or removed from Crown land without authority (Section 100, *FPC Act*), or stored on Crown land without authority (Section 101, *FPC Act*).
 - A vehicle which is transporting timber, timber products, botanical forest products or hay for which a violation of the *Forest Act* or the *FPC Act* as specified above, applies. NOTE: A vehicle seized must be released once it has delivered the seized timber, timber products or forest products, etc. to the location specified by the official.
